Physical Facilities will award several \$1,000 scholarships to students who are currently employed by BYU Physical Facilities. Any full-time Physical Facilities employee can nominate a student employee. Scholarships will be awarded at the PF Student Appreciation Lunch on April 20, 2023.

SCHOLARSHIP RULES

- Students must have worked at least two semesters for Physical Facilities (semesters do not have to be consecutive).
- Students must be enrolled in **and complete** a minimum of 12 credit hours in Fall 2023 to be eligible to receive this scholarship.
- The money awarded will be placed in the student’s BYU account for Fall 2023 to pay for tuition and books.
- Total awards for a student cannot exceed the cost of attendance.
- Nominee must be working at least 15 hours per week.
- The department supervisor must approve all nominations that go forward to the selection committee.
- In making your nomination you should use the values criteria for a guideline and provide information to help the selection committee get a good understanding of your nomination.
